NOTES: Tuesday through Thursday of Catholic Schools Week follows our Cathedral "Flashing Arrow" Dress Code Policy. Monday is a "Yellow" day.

-Students not following policy will call home for change of clothes.

-All dress up apparel must also be school appropriate.

-Consider recess and PE when choosing your apparel; adjust or bring a change of clothes as needed

-Students who choose not to dress in the day's theme may wear a CRC Eagle or "I Love Catholic Schools" shirt with uniform bottom.

Below is a common and quick language for our days out of dress code. Students who are not following the day's rules should meet with the teacher to determine if the student intentionally is skirting the guidelines, or it's accidental.

Dress Code Stop Light Policy

(Students may always choose to be in uniform on dress-up and theme days.)

Type	What this means for me
Red <i>(Spirit Top Day)</i>	"Spirit" wear with uniform shorts, pants, jumper or skirt. <i>The type of spirit apparel will be specified by Mr. Ekeler. For example, "Friday will be a RED dress day with Eagle spirit gear!"</i>
Yellow <i>(Jeans Day)</i>	Just like "Red" dress code day (above), but children may wear jeans. <i>The type of spirit wear will be specified by Mr. Ekeler. For example, "On Friday we will do a Yellow dress code day with Husker gear."</i>
Green	No uniform required! T-shirts, sweatshirts, shorts, jeans, and sweats are all in play.*
Flashing Arrow <i>(Theme Day)</i>	Theme days! These are most common during Catholic Schools Week or Red Ribbon Week, but students are only allowed out of uniform dress code if they are in theme dress.*

*Shirts must be school appropriate (no foul language, innuendo, or anything in opposition to CRC's mission).

*Apparel on the bottom may not have writing on the backside, may also not qualify as undergarments (like spandex, leggings).

*Shorts must reach (or be longer than) the person's fingertips when arms are fully extended to sides.
